The Trump administration has proposed drastic cuts in this year's budget.

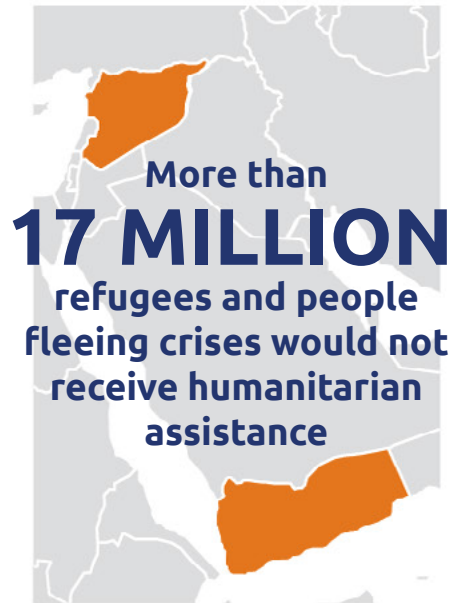
These cuts would mean that approximately :
